He is integrally involved with many high-profile public governmental tenders in Israel.

In more than 15 years of a wide-ranging environmental law practice, Doron's expertise has included drafting and accompanying the tender processes, handling litigation, and advising public sector and private clients in all stages of environment- and energy-related projects in Israel.

Doron's has represented Israel Natural Gas Lines Ltd. for many years and has assisted the company in numerous large and complex tenders and projects. In addition, he serves as lead counsel to the public sector in the solar-thermal project currently underway in the south of Israel, a project that involves construction of three solar power stations.

Doron has represented both public sector and private sector clients in numerous water desalination and sewage purification projects, including in the drafting of relevant documents, managing the tender process, handling litigation, and working with governmental and municipal bodies.

By representing the public sector in two of the country's largest transportation projects, the Jerusalem Light Rail and the Haifa Matronit (bus rapid transit system), Doron is playing a role in introducing the next generation of environmentally friendly public transportation in Israel.

involving light rail, as well as amendments to the Transportation Ordinance in regard to local authorities and their right to set parking rules. He has also provided hands-on assistance to legal advisors in the Ministry of Finance and the Ministry of Transportation.

Doron is co-author of Bills of Exchange: Case Law and has written numerous articles on tender law and renewable energy. He also co-authored with Yigal Arnon & Co. partner Orna Sasson the Israeli chapter on arbitration law in The Comparative Legal Guide to International Arbitration 2005. In addition, Doron lectures on tender law at a forum for senior Israeli executives.

Doron is a member of the Jerusalem District Committee of the Israel Bar Association, is Chairman of the Ethics Committee of the Jerusalem District and is a member of the National Ethics Committee. He serves as both a member of the executive board and as the Financial Committee Chairman of Bezhut, which assists physically challenged people in Israel, and is a former member of the managing board of the Association for Civil Rights in Israel.
